

Evolution (xvi)- the process of changing from simple to more complex over time.


"It is out of this process, known as evolution, that monkeys eventually developed into humans."

Origin (xii)- the starting place or the first.

Revolting (xv)- gross or disgusting.


*"Killing close relatives to our species, like monkeys, though it occurs, is **revolting** to most of us."*

Adapt (xv)- alter or change to make it more useful.


