<p>Foreigners (65)-an outsider, one that doesn't belong.</p> <p><i>“Even today, most fisherman in the world, no matter where they live, will say that the worst fishing practices are those done by foreigners.”</i></p>	 <p>https://pixabay.com/en/square-peg-wrong-fail-different-855294/</p>

Rational (67)- logical, makes sense.

*“This may be because they were **rational** reasons to think foreigners were the problem in Iceland.”*

Neglected (67)- ignoring basic needs, or not taking care of.

*“For centuries, the island was a **neglected** colony of Denmark, with little money spent to develop it.”*

Viking (67)- the ancient people that lived mainly in Denmark, Iceland, Sweden and Finland during the 8th-11th century. They were known as rugged seafaring pirates and traders.

*“Iceland was far poorer than North America or northern Europe, and Icelanders fished in small wooden open-deck boats powered by rows of men with oars- a boat not so different from those used by their **Viking** ancestors.”*

Lava-encrusted (67)- covered in hot liquid rock made from a volcano.


*“They would drag them into the sea in the cold, early morning from the **lava-encrusted** beaches.”*

Debate (68)- a argument of two or more differing opinions.

*“But here was a **debate** in Iceland between those who thought these boats should be kept out of their waters and those that thought Iceland should get a few of their own.”*

Intensified (68)- grew louder, or stronger.

*“A national **economy** based on the danger and uncertainty of commercial fishing was a common idea in earlier centuries, but by the twentieth century this was unusual.”*

Glaciers (68) - a slow moving river of ice.
